

Soccer Goal – Safety Information and Guidelines

- Unpack all parts and inspect for damage that may have occurred during shipping. If damage has occurred notify trucking company immediately.
- When assembling goals, follow instructions on the included installation instructions documents.
- Check for structural integrity and proper connecting hardware before every use. Replace damaged or missing parts or fasteners immediately. (ASTM F2950-14: Sec 11.2.1)
- Ensure safety/warning labels are clearly visible. Labels shall be placed under the crossbar and on the sides of the uprights at eye level (ASTM F2950-14: Sec 11.2.2). Frequently check to make sure safety/warning labels have not been removed or damaged. If replacement labels are needed, please call Keeper Goals for FREE replacement labels.
- Securely anchor movable soccer goals at ALL times, except when being moved.
 (ASTM F2950-14: Sec 11.2.3)
- Always instruct players, managers, coaches, trainers, teachers, maintenance and all other
 personnel who might come into contact with the goal on the safe handling of and potential
 dangers associated with movable soccer goals. (ASTM F2950-14: Sec 11.2.4)
- Always exercise extreme caution when moving goals and allow adequate manpower to move goals of varied sizes and weights. Movable soccer goals should only be moved by authorized and trained personnel. (ASTM F2950-14: Sec 11.2.5)
- NEVER allow anyone to climb on the net or goal framework. (ASTM F2950-14: Sec 11.2.6)
- Movable soccer goals should only be used on LEVEL fields, NEVER on a slope or hill area.
 (ASTM F2950-14: Sec 11.2.7)
- Remove nets when goals are not in use. (ASTM F2950-14: Sec 11.2.8)
- Most of the tip over injuries occurred when goals were unattended. Anchor or chain one goal
 to another, or to nearby fence posts, dugouts, or any other similar sturdy fixture when not in
 use. If this is not practical, store movable soccer goals in a place where children cannot have
 access to them. (ASTM F2950-14: Sec 11.2.9)

Soccer Goal – Safety Information and Guidelines (Cont.)

- Fully disassemble goals for seasonal storage (ASTM F2950-14: Sec 11.2.10). Properly store in a safe, secure location.
- Check to insure all connecting hardware is in place and are fully tightened before using this product.
- Frequently inspect all welds and connections to make sure welds are not cracked and that all joints and connections are secure.
- Exercise caution when setting up or taking down the net or goal framework. Soccer goals should only be assembled and disassembled by authorized personnel.
- Assembled soccer goals shall not be left unattended and never leave children unsupervised around soccer goals.
- Soccer goals are designed to be used for the game of soccer only.
- Nets shall be removed and soccer goals shall not be used during high wind storms.
- Any modifications to this or any Keeper Goals product will void any and all warranties.
