

MEASURING WALLS

1 Measure the width and height of walls

Do not include baseboards.

2 Measure width & height of any objects that may interfere with design.

Are there windows or doors? Fire alarms or extinguishers? Any object that needs to remain fixed to the wall needs to be measured.

3 Provide measurements to help locate where any objects are on the wall.

Help us in locating where an interfering object is located in relation to the wall. Measure from the floor to identify its location vertically. If needed, also measure from the left or right edge of the wall to identify its horizontal location.

4 Specify the surface.

Is the wall painted drywall? Is the wall brick or cinder block? We can apply to most surfaces but the type of material we use is dependent on the type of surface. Newly painted surfaces need to be dry and cured before applying graphics.

5 Provide photos of each wall and any other directions
